**PROCLAMATION NO. 813**

**DECLARING MONDAY, APRIL 25, 2005 AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)  
DAY IN THE CITY OF ISABELA, PROVINCE OF BASILAN**

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


