**RESOLUTION NO. 11050**

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Elections (Comelec) by virtue of the powers vested in it by the Constitution, the Omnibus Election Code and other election laws determines and allocates the number of seats of elective positions to be contested in a particular election;

**WHEREAS**, for the 12 May 2025 National and Local Elections (NLE) and Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao Parliamentary Elections (BPE), the elective positions to be contested are that of the Senators of the Republic of the Philippines, Members of the House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines (both legislative district and party-list representatives), Governors and Vice Governors of provinces, Members of the *Sangguniang Panlalawigan*, Mayors and Vice Mayors of cities and municipalities, Members of the *Sangguniang Panlungsod*, *Sangguniang Bayan*, and Members of Parliament of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM);

**WHEREAS**, as of this date, the Philippines consists of one (1) autonomous region, two hundred fifty-four (254) legislative districts,

eighty-two (82) provinces, one hundred forty-nine (149) cities, and one thousand four hundred ninety-three (1,493) municipalities;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 12000 creates the Negros Island Region, comprising the provinces of Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental and Siquijor, and the City of Bacolod;

**WHEREAS**, the number of Members of the House of Representatives to be elected is equal to the number of legislative districts;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11714 reapportioned the Province of Agusan del Norte into the Lone Legislative District of the City of Butuan and the legislative district of the Province of Agusan del Norte;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11804 reapportioned the Province of South Cotabato into three (3) Legislative Districts and separating the City of General Santos from the Third Legislative District of the Province of South Cotabato to constitute the Lone Legislative District of the City of General Santos;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11550, entitled "*An Act Dividing the Province of Maguindanao into Two (2) Provinces, Namely Maguindanao del Norte and Maguindanao del Sur*", was ratified in the plebiscite conducted on September 28, 2022;

**WHEREAS**, Minute Resolution No. 23-0020 dated 18 January 2023 approved the composition and divisions of Maguindanao del Norte and Maguindanao del Sur and the ten (10) seats each for Member of *Sangguniang Panlalawigan*;

**WHEREAS**, Minute Resolution No. 24-0194 dated 1 April 2024 approved the recommendation of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Maguindanao del Sur that the Municipality of Shariff Saydona Mustapha be transferred to the 1<sup>st</sup> District from the 2<sup>nd</sup> District of Maguindanao del Sur, hence, the following are the final list of municipalities under Provincial District I and II:

**WHEREAS**, Section 9 of Republic Act No. 11550, provides:

“SEC. 9. Legislative Districts. – Each province shall have its own legislative district comprising of the municipalities enumerated under Section 3 of this Charter, which shall take effect upon election and qualification of its representatives to be held on the second Monday of May 2022.

For the purpose of this section, the City of Cotabato shall be a part of the Lone Legislative District of the Province of Maguindanao del Norte. xxx”

**WHEREAS**, Republic Acts Numbered 10658, 11078, and 11395 created the Lone Legislative District of the Cities of Biñan, Calamba, and Santa Rosa, all in the Province of Laguna, respectively, giving the Province of Laguna with a total of seven (7) Legislative Districts;

**WHEREAS**, the number of Party-List representatives shall constitute twenty *per centum* (20%) of the total number of representatives;

**WHEREAS**, the number of contested positions for Governors and Vice Governors correspond to the number of provinces;

**WHEREAS**, according to the Bureau of Local Government Finance (BLGF), the income classifications of provinces, cities, and municipalities under Department of Finance (DOF) Order No. 23-08

dated 29 July 2008 are still in effect until the general income reclassification is conducted pursuant to Republic Act No. 11964, the "Automatic Income Reclassification Act of 2023";

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 of Republic Act No. 6636 as amended by Sec. 2 of Republic Act No. 6637, provides:

"Section 4. Provinces and other Municipalities. – First and second-class provinces shall each have ten (10) elective members for their respective Sangguniang Panlalawigan; third and fourth-class provinces, eight; and fifth and sixth class provinces, six (6), to be elected at large by the qualified voters therein'.

**WHEREAS**, Section 3 (a) (b), and (c) of Republic Act No. 7166, provides:

"Sec. 3. Election and Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panlungsod and Sangguniang Bayan – The elective members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Sangguniang Panlungsod and Sangguniang Bayan shall be elected as follows:

- (a) For provinces with two (2) or more legislative districts, the elective members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan shall be elected by legislative districts. For this purpose, the number of seats shall be apportioned equitably: Provided, That, if equal division is not possible, the remaining member or members shall be elected in the district or districts with the greater number of population or, if they be the same, with the greater number of voters. Provided, further, That a legislative district include a city that does not vote in the election of provincial officials, the Commission on Elections, shall allocate the number of seats among the districts in proportion to the population of the constituencies voting for the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.
- (b) For provinces with only one (1) legislative district, the Commission shall divide them into two (2) districts for purposes of electing the members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, as nearly as practicable according to number of inhabitants, each district comprising a compact, contiguous and adjacent territory, and the number of seats of elective members of their respective Sanggunian shall be equitably apportioned within the districts in accordance with the immediately preceding paragraph.
- (c) The number and election of elective members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod and Sangguniang Bayan in the Metro

Manila Area, City of Cebu, City of Davao and any other city with two (2) or more legislative districts shall continue to be governed by the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of Republic Act No. 6636, Provided, that, the municipalities of Malabon, Navotas, San Juan, Mandaluyong, Muntinlupa, Las Piñas and Taguig shall have twelve (12) councilors; and Pateros, ten (10), Provided, further, That, the Commission shall divide each of the municipalities in Metro Manila into two (2) districts by barangay for purposes of representation In the Sangguniang Bayan as nearly as practicable according to the number of inhabitants, each district comprising a compact, contiguous and adjacent territory”.

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act 8553 entitled, “*An Act Amending Section 41 (b) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code*”, provides:

“SECTION 1. Section 41 (b) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. The regular members of sangguniang panlalawigan, sangguniang panlungsod, and Sangguniang bayan shall be elected by districts, as follows:

First and second-class provinces shall have ten (10) members; third and fourth-class, eight (8); and fifth and sixth-class, six (6), Provided, That, in provinces with more than five (5) legislative districts, each district shall have two (2) sangguniang panlalawigan members, without prejudice to the provisions of Sec. 2 of Republic Act No. 6637 xxx”

**WHEREAS**, in *Florida Robes vs. Commission on Elections*, G.R. No. 257427, June 13, 2023, the Supreme Court ruled that the Lone Legislative District of the City of San Jose del Monte is entitled to two (2) seats in the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bulacan;

**WHEREAS**, the number of contested positions for Mayors and Vice Mayors is equal to the number of cities and municipalities;

**WHEREAS**, eight (8) new municipalities were created in the Province of North Cotabato from the sixty-three (63) barangays known as Special Geographic Areas of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, pursuant to the plebiscites conducted on 13 April 2024 in the affected barangays;

**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court in the *Municipality of Makati vs. Municipality of Taguig*, G.R. No. 235316, December 1, 2021, ruled that Barangays Cembo, Comembo, East Rembo, Pembo, Pitogo, Post Proper Northside, Post Proper Southside, Rizal, South Cembo, and West Rembo, belong to the City of Taguig and removed from the City of Makati;

**WHEREAS**, Sections 2 and 3 of Republic Act No. 6636 mandates, that:

"Section 2. Metro Manila Area – For purposes of the Local Elections on January 18, 1988, the City of Manila, Quezon City, and the City of Caloocan shall have six (6) councilors for each of their representative districts who shall be residents thereof to be elected by the qualified voters therein. The City of Pasay and the Municipalities of Makati, Parañaque, Pasig, Marikina, and Valenzuela, each of which comprises a representative district, shall have twelve (12) councilors each to be elected at large by the qualified voters of the said city or municipality. All other municipalities in the Metropolitan Manila area shall have ten (10) councilors each, with the exception of the Municipality of Pateros which shall have eight (8) councilors to be elected at large by their respective qualified voters.

Section 3. Other Cities – The provision of any to the contrary notwithstanding, the City of Cebu, the City of Davao, and any other city with more than one (1) representative district shall have eight (8) councilors for each district who shall be residents thereof to be elected by the qualified voters therein, provided that the Cities of Cagayan de Oro, Zamboanga, Bacolod, Iloilo, and other cities comprising a representative district shall have twelve (12) councilors each and all cities shall have ten (10) councilors to be elected at large by the qualified voters of the said cities: Provided, that, in no case shall the present number of councilors according to their charters be reduced";

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11054, entitled, "*An Act Providing for the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Repealing for the Purpose Republic Act No. 6734, entitled "An Act Providing for an Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, As Amended by Republic Act No. 9054, entitled "An Act to Strengthen and Expand the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao"*", provides that the following areas form the BARMM:

1. Basilan, excluding the City of Basilan
2. Lanao del Sur
3. Maguindanao, including the City of Cotabato

4. Sulu
5. Tawi-Tawi
6. Sixty-three (63) barangays from the different Municipalities of North Cotabato”;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6, Article VII, Republic Act No. 11054, provides:

“Section 6. Composition. – The Parliament shall be composed of eighty (80) members, unless otherwise increased by the Congress of the Philippines”;

**WHEREAS**, Section 7 (a) (b) (c), Article VII, Republic Act 11054, classified and allocated the Parliament seats, as follows:

“Section 7. Classification and Allocation of Seats. – The seats in the Parliament shall be classified and allocated as follows:

- a. One-half of the members of Parliament shall be representatives of political parties who are elected through a system of proportional representation based on the Bangsamoro territorial jurisdiction.
- b. Parliamentary District Seats – Not more than forty per cent (40%) of the members of Parliament shall be elected from single member parliamentary districts apportioned for the areas and in the manner provided for by the Parliament.
- c. Reserved Seats and Sectoral Representatives. – Reserved seats and sectoral representatives shall constitute ten percent (10 %) of the members of Parliament, which shall include two (2) reserved seats each for non-Moro indigenous peoples and settler communities. Women, youth, traditional leaders, and the Ulama shall have one sectoral seat each, Provided, that the reserved seats and sectoral seats shall in no case be less than eight (8) seats.”

**WHEREAS**, party representatives are members of registered regional political parties that are able to receive at least four *per centum* (4%) of the total valid votes cast for the party system election;

**WHEREAS**, Bangsamoro Transition Authority (BTA) Parliamentary Bill No. 27 proposes the following allocation of Parliamentary districts in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao:

1. Basilan three (3)
2. Lanao del Sur, eight (8)
3. Maguindanao del Norte, four (4)
4. Maguindanao del Sur, four (4)
5. Sulu, seven (7)
6. Tawi-Tawi, three (3)
7. Cotabato City, two (2)
8. Special geographic areas, one (1)

**WHEREAS**, except for the non-Moro indigenous peoples, *Ulama*, and traditional leader's representatives, the sectoral representatives shall be elected through a direct plurality of votes cast for the respective sectors, the election of the sectoral representatives to commence in the 2028 elections;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commission **RESOLVED**, as it **HEREBY RESOLVES**, to fix the number and allocation of seats for the 12 May 2025 National and Local Elections as shown below, and itemized in Annexes "A" to "F":
