[MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 146]

AN ACT CREATING BARANGAY TALIBADOK IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SHARIFF AGUAK, PROVINCE OF MAGUINDANAO, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Regional Legislative Assembly in session assembled:


SECTION 1. The sitios of Talibadok, Gandingan and Tangkapa are hereby created into a separate, distinct and regular barangay from its Mother Barangay Satan, Municipality of Shariff Aguak, Province of Maguindanao, to be known as Barangay Talibadok.

SEC. 2. As created, Barangay Talibadok shall be bounded by natural and duly designated boundaries with a total area of 380.81 hectares more specifically described as follows:

“Beginning on the point of origin Point 1, the line moves due Northeast bearing 86°05’ for approximately 3,280 meters along Barangay Meta towards Point 2; thence, the line continues Southeast bearing 11°55’ for 900 meters along the National Highway to Point 3; thence going Southwest at approximately 2,850 meters bearing 71°4’ along Barangay Putingbato towards Point 4; thence moving Northeast bearing 29°10’ for 1,540 meters along Barangay Limpongo closing the traverse going back to the point of origin, Point 1.”

SEC. 3. The corporate existence of this barangay shall commence upon the appointment of the punong barangay and majority of the members of its Sangguniang Barangay.

SEC. 4. The punong barangay and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Barangay shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Municipality of Shariff Aguak immediately after the ratification of this Act.

The chairman and seven (7) members of the Sangguniang Kabataan shall be appointed by the punong barangay concerned after consultation with the Municipal Mayor and Department of Interior and Local Government-ARMM.

All concerned shall hold office and perform their respective functions in accordance with MMA Act No. 25 until their successors shall have been elected and qualified in the next barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan regular elections.


SEC. 5. The Commission on Elections (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite called for the purpose in the affected areas upon the request of the Municipal Mayor within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act.

SEC. 6. This barangay shall be entitled to an equitable share from the unexpended balance of the annual Internal Revenue Allotment share of its Mother Barangay until its own annual share from Internal Revenue Allotment(IRA) shall have been determined and released by the national government.

SEC. 7. The expenses necessary in the holding of plebiscite for the purpose shall be appropriated by the Sangguniang Bayan from any available funds in its Municipal Treasury.


SEC. 8. The creation of Barangay Talibadok shall take effect when approved by majority of the votes cast in the plebiscite called for the purposes.
