ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 114

CREATING A COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE THE DEFUNCT IMPORT CONTROL
COMMISSION.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I, RAMON
MAGSAYSAY, President of the Philippines, do hereby create a
committee to investigate the defunct Import Control Commission.
The Committee shall be composed of the following:


1st Assistant Corporate Counsel Simeon M.
Gopengco - - - - - Chairman
Mr. Alfredo Velayo - - - - - Member
Mr. Cirilo Miran - - - - - Member

The Committee is hereby granted all the powers of an inves-
tigating committee under Sections 71 and 580 of the Revised
Administrative Code, including the power to summon witnesses,
administer oaths, and take testimony or evidence relevant to the
investigation. It is also authorized to call upon any department,
bureau, office, agency or instrumentality of the Government for
such assistance or information as it may require in the performance
of its functions, and for this purpose, it shall have access to,
and the right to examine, any books, documents, papers or records
thereof.

The Committee shall submit its report and recommendations
to the President of the Philippines within the shortest time
possible.

Done in the City of Manila, this 16th day of April, in the
year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, and of the
Independence of the Philippines, the ninth.
