PROCLAMATION NO. 183

DECLARING THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 18 TO 24, 1999, AS "PRINTING INDUSTRY WEEK"

WHEREAS, the printing industry, as one of the most effective tools in communication, contributes to the furtherance of the country's goal towards national economic growth;


WHEREAS, the Printing Industry of the Philippines will hold its 9th National Printers Convention on October 18 to 20, 1999 with the theme "Innovative Approaches During Crisis;"
