PROCLAMATION NO. 664

**DECLARING SATURDAY, JULY 10, 2004, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)
DAY IN SANTA ROSA, LAGUNA**

WHEREAS, the Commission on Elections will conduct the plebiscite on July 10, 2004, to ratify the conversion of the municipality of Santa Rosa in the Province of Laguna into a component city to be known as the City of Santa Rosa, pursuant to Republic Act No. 9264;

WHEREAS, in order to give the people of Santa Rosa, Laguna ample time to exercise their right to vote, there is a need to declare July 10, 2004 as special (non-working) day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERTO G. ROMULO, Executive Secretary, by order of Her Excellency, **GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO**, do hereby declare Saturday, July 10, 2004, as special (non-working) day in Santa Rosa, Laguna.


