WHEREAS, Wednesday, September 8, 2004, marks the 4th *Foundation Day* anniversary of the City of Digos, Davao del Sur;


WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of the City of Digos be given full opportunity to celebrate this milestone in their city's history with appropriate ceremonies.
