**DECLARING MONDAY, JULY 24, 2006, AS SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)
DAY IN THE CITY OF GINGOOG**

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


