**WHEREAS**, coinciding with the feast day is the holding of the Coconut Festival and Mardi Gras Contest;


**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the City of San Pablo be given full opportunity to celebrate the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


