**PROCLAMATION NO. 1189**

**DECLARING FRIDAY, 20 MARCH 2026, A REGULAR HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY IN OBSERVANCE OF *EID'L FITR* (FEAST OF RAMADHAN)**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 9177, amending Section 26, Chapter 7, Book I of Executive Order No. 292, declared *Eidul Fitr* (*Eid'l Fitr*) as a regular holiday throughout the country;

**WHEREAS**, the National Commission on Muslim Filipinos has recommended the declaration of 20 March 2026, (Friday), or 21 March 2026 (Saturday) as a national holiday in observance of *Eid'l Fitr* (Feast of Ramadhan);

**WHEREAS**, in order to bring the religious and cultural significance of the *Eid'l Fitr* to the fore of national consciousness, and to allow the entire Filipino nation to join their Muslim brothers and sisters in peace and harmony in the observance and celebration of *Eid'l Fitr*, it is necessary to declare 20 March 2026, Friday, a regular holiday throughout the country.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND R. MARCOS, JR.**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Friday, 20 March 2026, a regular holiday throughout the country in observance of *Eid'l Fitr* (Feast of Ramadhan).

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.
