PROCLAMATION NO. 1400

DECLARING SATURDAY, 12 SEPTEMBER 2026, A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING)
DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SQUIJOR, PROVINCE OF SQUIJOR

WHEREAS, on 12 September 1972, President Ferdinand E. Marcos signed Proclamation No. 1075 declaring the Municipality of Siquijor as the capital of the Province of Siquijor;

WHEREAS, on 12 September 2026, Saturday, the Municipality of Siquijor, Province of Siquijor will mark the celebration of its 54th Anniversary as the capital of the Province of Siquijor;

WHEREAS, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the Municipality of Siquijor be given full opportunity to participate in the occasion and enjoy the celebration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RALPH G. RECTO, Acting Executive Secretary, by authority of the President, **FERDINAND R. MARCOS, JR.**, do hereby declare Saturday, 12 September 2026, a special (non-working) day in the Municipality of Siquijor, Province of Siquijor.
