AN ACT REPEALING REPUBLIC ACTS NUMBERED

SIXTY-ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE AND FIFTY-FOUR
HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR (RE: PROHIBITION TO
CATCH FISH CALLED "IPON" DURING CERTAIN
MONTHS OF THE YEAR, ETC.)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Republic Acts Numbered Sixty-one hundred forty-five and Fifty-four hundred seventy-four are hereby repealed by this Act.

- SEC. 2. All provisions of existing laws, orders, decrees, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are likewise repealed.
 - SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
