[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 12127]

AN ACT CONVERTING THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE EXTENSION OFFICE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GATTARAN, PROVINCE OF CAGAYAN, INTO A REGULAR LTO DISTRICT OFFICE AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The existing Land Transportation Office (LTO) extension office in the Municipality of Gattaran, Province of Cagayan, is hereby converted into a regular LTO district office to be known as the Gattaran LTO District Office.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Transportation shall immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the Gattaran LTO District Office, the initial

funding of which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the LTO extension office in the Municipality of Gattaran, Province of Cagayan. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for the continued operation of the Gattaran LTO District Office shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
